

MSSA Scholarship Program

OBJECTIVE

Minnesota Street Superintendents Association (MSSA) scholarships are intended to financially assist individuals in public works academic, technical, or closely related programs and training. Scholarships are intended to increase interest in the public works profession by publicizing MSSA and its Scholarship Program.

CRITERIA

- 1) Applicants must be a Minnesota resident or a MSSA member, but not necessarily attending a Minnesota School.
- 2) Preference will be given to MSSA members, their spouse, or dependent.
- 3) Consideration will be given to financial need, academic achievements, character, participation in professional organizations, and any previous work experience in the area of public works.
- 4) Eligibility is limited to a lifetime maximum of two MSSA scholarship awards.

SCHOLARSHIP AMOUNTS

Four \$750.00 (maximum) scholarships per budget year are available.

All applicants must submit a letter of reference from an instructor, academic counselor, or a public works professional indicating knowledge of the applicant's character and career interest in the field of public works.

- ✓ Three part cover letter/essay (1-2 pages) describing:
 - 1) How you plan to use your certificate/degree/training.
 - 2) Your extracurricular activities, volunteer work, and involvement in professional organizations, if any.
 - 3) Financial need and any special circumstances.
- ✓ Letter of reference from an instructor, academic counselor, or public works professional indicating knowledge of your character and career in the field of public works.
- ✓ Provide the name and relation of the MSSA member if you are a spouse or dependent.
